Dear Members,

The last few months have been both encouraging and challenging for the Indian textile industry. While global uncertainties continue to influence markets, there have also been several positive developments that give us confidence about the future.

One of the most significant developments for our industry is the India-UK Free Trade Agreement, which has now come into force. With duty-free access for Indian textile and apparel products to the UK market, our exporters have an opportunity to become more competitive and expand their presence in one of India's important export destinations. It is now for the industry to make the most of this opportunity through innovation, quality, reliability and timely delivery.

Export performance during the first part of the current financial year has, however, presented a mixed picture. During April-May 2026, textile exports grew by about 3%, reflecting the resilience of the sector. At the same time, apparel exports declined by nearly 13%, resulting in an overall decline of about 4.4% in India's combined textile and apparel exports. Weak consumer demand in the US and parts of Europe, softer demand from the Middle East due to war conditions, and increasing competition from neighbouring manufacturing countries have all contributed to this slowdown. We should also remember that exports during the corresponding period last year were exceptionally strong, making this year's comparison more demanding.

The Government has continued to support the textile sector through initiatives such as the expansion of the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme, the progress of PM MITRA Parks and renewed efforts to improve cotton productivity. These are welcome steps that will help strengthen the textile value chain, encourage investment and create new opportunities for growth.

Sustainability itself is no longer just a desirable objective. It is rapidly becoming an essential part of doing business globally. Circularity, responsible sourcing, recycling and traceability are increasingly influencing buying decisions. I believe Indian industry is well placed to respond to these changing expectations and convert them into long-term opportunities.

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Another area that continues to excite me is Technical Textiles. With applications ranging from healthcare and infrastructure to agriculture, defence and mobility, this sector offers tremendous potential for future growth. Keeping this in view, the Mumbai Unit is organising a one-day seminar on "Future Trends in Technical Textiles" on 22nd August 2026 at Fortune Park Galaxy, Vapi. I warmly invite all our members and industry colleagues to participate in this important programme.

During the last quarter, we also organised an international webinar on "Cradle to Cradle – Paving a Way to Sustainable Textiles." The excellent response from participants once again demonstrated the industry's growing interest in sustainable manufacturing and circular economy practices. My sincere thanks to our distinguished speaker, Ms. Nienke Steen, and to our knowledge partner, BluWin, for making the webinar a great success.

At the Mumbai Unit, we remain committed to providing meaningful platforms for learning, networking and sharing knowledge. I sincerely thank all our members, speakers, sponsors, volunteers and well-wishers for their continued encouragement and support. Your participation is what keeps our Association vibrant and relevant.
